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Reference: The contents of this document are taken from the Bible, and from the books called Doctrines of Devils by Francis B, from the dramatic conversion to Jesus of Phil Botha in the book called: Magus Thor'rauna High Priest of Satan in South Africa and from the book titled Prepare for War by Rebecca Brown.

It is recommended that anyone wishing to access the more comprehensive account, explanation and information contained in this document, should purchase these books.



Introduction

The Bible in 1 Tim 4:1 makes specific reference to 'doctrines of devils', that it will cause some to depart from the faith.

Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;

I had always wondered, exactly what these doctrines were and how they affect us all. However the Bible doesn't tell us specifically 'what' these doctrines of devils are, only that they exist.

This document will provide insight on what these doctrines actually are.



Background Information

In order to understand the context for information in this document, there are some facts that need to established.

- 1. 35 subjects were created by demonic spirits for the specific purpose of being used in the final onslaught against the body of Christ as described in the Bible.
- 2. Over 2,000 professional practising witches in Satanism converted to Christianity, when Phil Botha exposed those doctrines in the first two years of his ministry in the evangelical churches across Johannesburg, Pretoria, Durban and Pietermaritzburg.
- 3. Since the Holy Spirit anointed Paul the apostle to prophesy about the falling away from the faith, no Christian ministers had been able to preach on the doctrines as they were only taught in Satanism. That is until God orchestrated the escape and salvation of Phil Botha the Magus High Priest to receive Jesus as his Lord and Master.

An Important Fact and Warning

If any person who claims to be born again, saved, converted, Spirit-filled, backslidden, lukewarm or just paying lip service to their fellowship with Jesus, has ever dabbled in, attended, believed in, participated in, practised or used any of these doctrines of devils, even if only done once, you have sinned, broken your God given hedge of spiritual protection and you have allowed demons into your life.

We will now give a brief explanation of these doctrines.

1. Astrology

Astrology is placing your trust, curiousity, faith (think weekly or even daily interest) in the stars and believing that the date of your birth corresponds to a star sign (signs of the zodiac) and these star signs determine your personality and destiny.

Participating in astrology is also supposed to help you see what the future holds for you next, week, next month, next year, or years to come via the stars, without inquiring from God your creator, which was the exact method that Nimrod (Bible scholars here will recognise this name of an originator of witchcraft) used to seek his destiny which led to the tower of Babel (requiring God to intervene).

Key Point to Note

Witches are ordered on a monthly basis to invoke certain spirits whose task it is to harm and mentally unbalance all those who have zodiac signs/symbols on mugs, cups, sewn into their clothing, worn around their necks, on bags at home, tattooed on their bodies. These attacks are specifically targeted at and affect people spiritually during the one month of the particular zodiac sign being followed by that person.

2. Fortune Telling

Fortune telling is the enquiring into future events from a source other than God, which in practise is actually seeking direction from demons.

Fortune telling includes palm or teacup reading, tarot cards, African bone throwing, the old pendulum, crystal ball, clairvoyance, Ouija Board (also know as glassy-glassy).

All books about Mystery and Babylonian Scret Rites handed down over the years for the sole purpose of keeping the flame of this Movement alive, confirm the biblical account of Noahs great grandson Nimrod, who built the and established, with demonic help, the very first city and his own empire after the flood. Nimrod thus became the head of a false religion in open defiance of and rebellion against the Lord God

Key Point to Note

All fortune telling and astrology in the days of Nimrod was created and used to instill doubt and mistrust towards the one and only true living God.

3. The Ouija Board

The Ouija Board is used to conjure up and incorrectly invoke specific demons that apparently have the insight and wisdom into the future and destiny of those who conjured them.

By participating in the use of a Ouija board, many people have opened themselves up to demons and ended up in mental institutions or worse. Subsequent to that many of these people end up losing their souls for all eternity.



The Ouija board and it's use has become more main stream and so you can this occultic device from outlets and stores such as Amazon!!

Key Point to Note

In 1975, a well known British doctor who was practising in Harley Street, disclosed some information that people found horrifying, he had taken hundreds of EEG tests and coupled with specially designed brain scans, that 60% of all nervous and mental patients in British institutions were committed due to their personal involvement in the use of the Ouija Board or clairvoyance.

4. Yoga, Meditation, Transcendental Meditation and Reincarnation.

In order to understand these next three doctrines of devils, we must first take a closer look at the basic teachings of Hinduism (and the New Age) which is where these doctrines originate from.

However if you feel you have a sufficiently good understanding of Hinduism, you may skip ahead to Section 6 – Yoga on Page 20

The basic teachings of Hinduism and the New Age

The entire world and universe and everything within it is God. In other words, God is an impersonal force which makes up everything in existence. There is no difference between creature and creator as both are one.

This is ultimate reality: everything is a part of a formless, inexpressible, unknowable force which is called Brahman. In the Western Hemisphere, Brahman is often called the "God force." Brahman is all and all is Brahman.

The goal for all Hindus is to come to "self-realization." This is the realization that they themselves are Brahman. "Self-realization" is achieved when these people gain control of their spirits.

The human spirit is considered to be Brahman. Yoga manuals often refer to this gaining contact with, and control of, the human spirit as a "state of God consciousness." Brahman is not a god as we think of gods. Brahman is at the same time everything and yet nothing. As you can see, by the very difficulty of trying to define Brahman, the entire 189 concept goes against all logic and everything in our physical world. To compensate for this, the term maya is used.

Maya refers to the Hindu concept that everything which we see, touch or feel in our physical world is actually just an illusion, it really doesn't exist.

When a Hindu reaches an advanced state of "self-realization" he has so withdrawn from the physical world into the spirit world that he no longer has a conscious awareness of anything in the physical world.



When this state is reached the person is incapable of caring for themselves and can no longer communicate with the physical world. In the medical field in the West, he is in what is described as a permanent state of "catatonia." These people are worshiped in India and other lands as great gods, their every bodily need cared for by their worshipers as if they were babies.

They never speak or move on their own. We, in the West, would consider such a person totally insane, yet, millions of people in our country are now trying to reach such a state.


In Hinduism, reincarnation is considered to be the "wheel" of life. The spirit never changes, it just changes bodies in life after life in an endless cycle of reincarnation. Each person dies to live again in a different form.

Eastern Hinduism teaches that a person can come back as a bug or a bird or even as a plant.

The only escape from this terrible burden of reincarnation is to gain unity with Brahman. At that point, the person at death no longer needs to reincarnate but can continue to exist in a formless spiritual state. It's interesting, in the East reincarnation is considered a curse, in the West it has become a fad and something desirable.

Karma is the Hindu law of cause and effect. Every act, thought, or word produces an effect. Since these "effects" cannot all be experienced in one life time, then the person must continually reincarnate to live out the effects of his acts in previous lives.

However, it is basically impossible to "live" without doing acts of some sort which then produces more karma which must be lived out in future lives. It is a never ending cycle from which there is no escape.



Wheel of Life and Death - frequent Hindu symbol used to represent reincarnation, which is the perpetual cycle of birth, death and rebirth, from which man is supposedly liberated when he achieves "self-realization."

Therefore the attainment of a state of total inactivity or withdrawal from the physical world helps bring this vicious cycle of karma to an end. There is no forgiveness in



karma, each person must suffer for his own deeds. Yet, at the same time, the godforce called Brahman is everything, and therefore is both good and evil. There is no acknowledgment of sin as such.

There is only one escape from this whole terrible unending cycle. That is into a state of nirvana. Nirvana is similar to our concept of heaven except that it is not a definite place.

Rather it is a state of being. It is nothingness which is considered to be a blissful absence from feeling either pleasure or pain through the pure extinction of personal existence. When this state is reached, the person is then said to have been absorbed into Brahman or pure

Being which is a state of nothingness. Only by reaching a state of nirvana can a person escape at last from the terrible cycle of having to live out his karma in endless reincarnations.

There are thousands of Hindu gods, naturally, as everything and everybody is god.

However, there are a few that receive more worship than others. One of the main gods is called Shiva.

Shiva is a god of destruction who has a wife named Kali, the mother goddess of power, illness and death.

Shiva is represented in drawings as having a cobra coiled around his neck or head. The serpent or cobra is worshiped extensively throughout Hinduism.

It is not unusual to hear Shiva referred to as a "god of light" by various yoga teachers. They represent Shiva as something very desirable.

Yoga students are taught to "reach for Shiva, or light." The average Western yoga student has no idea of who or what Shiva really is. When they reach out to the "light of Shiva," they are reaching out to a demon god.

Various practices are faithfully followed in Hinduism to enable a person to more quickly reach the state of nirvana and to escape from the endless wheel of reincarnation. Yoga and meditation are the two most important tools. The word yoga literally means "to yoke," or "bind together."

The goal of yoga is to blank out the mind, stop all movement of the body, cut off all sensation of the physical world, and thereby attain union with Brahman in a state of nothingness.

The various yoga practices are specifically designed to induce a trance state of mindlessness which is supposed to draw the person up into a union with Brahman.

What is actually happening, is that as the person meditates to blank out their mind, they are opening themselves up to the entrance of demons. These demons then give them all sorts of experiences in the spirit world and the link between their soul and spirit is forged.



Many experience astral projection and direct contact with demons which masquerade as the various Hindu gods. Shiva - Hindu God, traditionally regarded as the original founder of Yoga.

Brahman - One of the common representations of this Hindu god who is considered to be everything. The purpose of Yoga is to bring the practitioner into union with Brahman.

Please note, Yoga is for one purpose only, union with Brahman. It cannot be separated from the demonic religion which created it.

There are several different types of yoga as presented here in the Western Hemisphere. Hatha yoga, which is supposedly only physical exercise. Kundalini yoga, which is used heavily by the medical field, and promises healing of the mind and body.

Tantra yoga is also used by the medical field and is becoming very popular amongst top executives of the large corporations.

Tantra yoga is pure satanism right down to the human sacrifices. The beginners of tantra yoga usually do not realize what they are getting into.

All sorts of sexual perversions are common in this type of yoga. There are many other types of yoga.

Four main types are used within Hinduism: Karma yoga, Bhakti yoga, Jnana yoga and Raja yoga.

Each of these four are supposed to be used by people of different "natures."

However, all yoga has one goal: "All paths [of yoga] lead ultimately to the same destination - to union with Brahman or God - and the lessons of each of them need to be integrated if true wisdom is to be attained." (The Sivananda Companion to YOGA, by Lucy Lidell, Fireside Books, 1983, p. 18)

Because yoga is presented in a multitude of publications under the guise of science, people accept the terminology that comes with it, without ever researching to find the true meaning of those terms.

Yoga is usually found in many books in the average bookstore under sections for "health" and "physical fitness."

It should be presented under "religion." I want to illustrate a few of these terms and show you just what they actually mean. The basic postures or positions in yoga are called asanas.

Breathing exercises play a large part in yoga. The correct breathing for yoga is often called pranayama.




The purpose of the asanas and pranayama, is to facilitate the flow of prana. Just what is prana? It is simply described in most yoga texts as being a "vital energy" which must flow through the body.

This "vital energy" is really talking about a spirit, that is, more specifically, a demon spirit! Let us look at a statement from a yoga textbook and then analyze what it really means.

"The ultimate purpose of both asanas and pranayama is to purify the nadis or nerve channels so that prana can flow freely through them, and to prepare the body for the raising of Kundalini, the supreme cosmic energy, which leads the yogi to a state of God consciousness." (Ibid., p. 29)

Do you see what this is saying? It is saying that the various positions and the breathing is preparing the body so that the demon god called Kundalini can actually enter into the body and flow through it!


Yoga is specifically for the purpose of opening up the practitioner to the entrance of demons. I have illustrated some of the common asanas (yoga positions) and their true purpose and meaning.




The Cobra - a common yoga position.

"By the practice of this posture the serpent-goddess (the Kundalini force) awakes." (Yoga, p. 50)





Surya Namasakar- also called the "Sun Salutation." Series of positions used in the West for "warm-up" exercises in yoga. Each position is a posture of worship of the sun god. (Called Baal in the Bible.) Traditionally it is performed at dawn. facing the rising sun.



The

Lotus - yoga position symbolizing man's "spiritual evolution." This position is to aid the now of prana, and aid the "clearing of the mind" in meditation.

Mantras are used both in the direct worship of gods and in yoga and all forms of meditation. (T.M. and Zen have become very popular in the U.S. This same technique is used in the New Age classes of self-improvement and mind control and in Buddhism.)



A mantra is the rapid repetition of a series of words or sounds. It has two purposes. The first is to produce a mystical state which is actually a trance in which the mind is blanked out. This in turn places the person into direct contact with the spirit world.

Secondly, the mantra is supposed to actually "embody" a spiritual being. As the words are spoken, the being comes into existence and enters the person using the mantra. Mantras are a direct doorway opening up the person to the entrance of demons. "Mantras are Sanskrit syllables, words or phrases which, when repeated in meditation, will bring the individual to a higher state of consciousness. [i.e. into contact with the spirit world.] ... it has a certain metre and a presiding deity [demon] ... " (Ibid., p. 98)

The words of the mantra are not particularly important, the repetition is what is important. Rapid repetition helps to blank out the mind. As you understand this mechanism, you begin to realize the importance of the frequently repeated phrases and choruses in ALL forms of Rock Music, and in the Catholic rosary.

You will also understand why Jesus told us that repetitious prayers "as the pagans do" are unacceptable. Rock music provides countless people with mantras which summon demons to come to them and at the same time opens them up to demonic entrance through their blanked out minds. Mala - a string of beads used in reciting a mantra.

The mantra phrase or "prayer" is repeated for each bead. Rosary - a string of "prayer beads" used in Roman Catholicism. The prayer "Hail Mary" is repeated for each small bead and "Our Father" for each large bead in the same type of repetition as a mantra.

It is important to understand these basic concepts because it is impossible to start sharing the gospel with someone involved either in Hinduism or the New Age Movement without first defining what you mean by the very word "God." To them, "God" is an impersonal nothingness which is, at the same time, everything.

To us, He is the distinct personal Creator. However, what is most dangerous is that these basic Hindu teachings have been cloaked in Western terminology and even in Christian terms.

The medical field particularly has been completely invaded by Hinduistic practices taught as "science." Yoga, bio-feedback, alpha brain wave control, homeopathy, acupuncture, holistic medicine, all of these are based on Hindu practices and presented to the public as scientific.

Even in the field of oncology, the teaching of what is called "terminal breathing" and various relaxation techniques are being widely taught to patients on the cancer wards and in hospices.

The goal of this teaching is to teach the patient how to slow down their breathing to the point of stopping altogether, thus bringing about death much earlier than it would normally occur.



Don't forget, the goal of yoga is physical death. The subtlety is great! The scriptures themselves have been taken out of context and twisted to try to support these demonic doctrines. Let me give some examples directly from the writings of the New Agers which will quickly show you just how important it is to test the New Age spirits. The New Agers use such terms as "Christ consciousness," the "Christ within," the "God force," and even use the term "born again."

I have quoted here from some of the leading writers of this movement. As you read these passages carefully you will recognize the hidden Hindu teachings. "There is a great deal of talk these days about being 'born again.' In Jesus' teaching, to be born again is to realize our own identity as a Son of God - just like him! He was (and is) the Self-expression of the Infinite Power of the Universe - just like you are.

The only difference between you and Jesus is that he fully realized the Truth about himself and you haven't - yet. It is all a matter of degree. He was a Superbeing in perfection. You are one in potential.

But never forget one of his most significant statements- 'I said, ye are gods.' How do we realize our divinity? Jesus said, 'You must change your hearts.'

In modern terms he was saying 'Change the patterns in your subconscious mind, because what the subconscious believes is outpictured in your body and affairs."' (The Super Beings, by John Randolph Price, Quartus Books, 1981, p. 57)

Do you see how deceptive this is? You can go round and round with a New Ager if you don't pin them down to their exact definition of which Jesus and which God they are talking about.

They believe that we human beings ARE DIVINE, just as the Hindus believe every human is a part of Brahman. The quote "I said ye are gods" comes out of Psalm 82.

The New Agers use this as a proof text that we human beings are divine and equal with God our Creator. This particular quote gives a lot of Christians trouble when trying to talk with New Agers about their need for a Savior.

Let's look at that scripture in context:

"God standeth in the congregation of the mighty; he judgeth among the gods. How long will ye judge unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked? Selah. Defend the poor and fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy ... I have said, Ye are gods; and all of you are children of the most High. But ye shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes." Psalm 82:1-7

There are two significant facts here which the New Agers choose to overlook. First, the one true God, the Creator, clearly is so much more powerful than the beings He refers to as "gods," that He places judgment upon them and condemns them to die like men.

That alone shows a clear distinction between the beings referred to as "gods" and human beings.



Secondly, the Hebrew word for "gods" used in that text is defined as "magistrates" or, in other words, administrators or rulers, also sometimes used for angels. (Strong's Exhaustive Concordance, word 430 in Hebrew.)

There is a vast difference between the infinite God, Creator of all, and the beings referred to as "gods." These "gods" are created beings just as we humans are created.

These were, apparently, fallen angels condemned to die like men because of their wickedness. Jesus quotes this scripture in John 10:35. But in His quote He again clearly differentiates between these created "gods" and the Creator God.

Paul finalizes the issue in Corinthians:

"For though there be that are called gods, whether in heaven or in earth, (as there be gods many, and lords many,) But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him." I Corinthians 8:5-6

Again, this scripture clearly shows that the "gods" are created beings, the Creator is the one true God. This section goes on further to state that Jesus Christ is that one true God, because all things were created by this Jesus. Many other scriptures also make this statement such as Colossians 1:12-18 and John 1:1-5.

Therefore, scripture clearly shows that Jesus Christ is uniquely divine in nature which we human beings can never be. We will always be created beings, Jesus will always be the Creator. Let us look at another quote which continues this lie that human beings are divine.

"Many speak via the avenue of mass media from the platform of organized religion and from the Bible, and so there is credibility to their words. But if they condemn and judge others, if they preach self-degradation, if they rally the masses against a particular segment of society, if they attempt to limit the individual's freedom of choice with any form of repression, and if they spread fear of God and mistrust toward man, they are not teaching the Truth ... God is, and man is his Self expression. When man realizes his identity, a race of gods will rule the universe as Sons and Daughters of the Most High, the Father of All." (The Super Beings, p. 46-47)

"For most people, the door to the inner Presence is closed. 'I stand at the door and knock' said the Christ through Jesus. Until that door is opened, each soul is in evolutionary training, and this is where the Law of Karma comes into play. Remember we are here for one purpose only, and that is to find our way back to the Father's house - to be the true Self-expression of the Infinite.

If our soul is evolving, and more and more Light is entering our consciousness, we are said to be on the Path ... if the foundation (of religion) is based on One Presence, One Infinite Love, One Power, One God, One Supreme Being, One Father, with each individual a spiritual manifestation of



the One, and with the Oneness of God and man as the central theme, then you are approaching the High Religion taught by the Masters." (Ibid, p. 44-45)

Note here that this line of New Age teaching makes a distinction between "Christ" and "Jesus." In other words, they deny the unique divinity of Jesus, but say that "Christ" spoke through a man called Jesus.

They deny that there is any difference between Jesus and the rest of us humans. They claim that this "Christ" spirit was also in Budda, Mohammed, Krishna, etc. They teach that God is an impersonal "force" which has to have a way of manifesting and experiencing existence.

They teach that each human being is a manifestation of God, thus wiping out any difference between the creature and the Creator. This leads to the inevitable conclusion: "These men and women are not running around playing God. They are God." (Ibid., p. 27)

"The Spirit of God where you are - in and around and through you - is your Spirit." (Ibid., p. 34.)

And finally to the greatest possible error: "The idea of 'original sin' is totally false ... The High Religion has nothing to do with sin, only the spiritual development of man." (Ibid., p. 12.)

Where there is no sin, there is no need of a Saviour. But the Bible tells us that we have all sinned.

"For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23 "As it is written, There is none righteous, no not one." Romans 3: 10

It all goes back to the original temptation in the garden of Eden:

"And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil." Genesis 3:4,5

What Satan didn't tell Eve was that the "gods" she would then be like were demons! This deceptive teaching that human beings are divine and that there is no difference between creature and Creator is beautifully summed up in Romans.

"Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, and changed the glory of the uncorruptable God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and four-footed beasts, and creeping things. Wherefore God also gave them up to the uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves: Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshiped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever." Romans 1:22-25

These New Age teachings are sweeping the U.S. and rest of the free world. A large number of our top governmental leaders accept these teachings. Executives of most



large corporations are involved in classes and activities pushing Hinduistic philosophies presented as scientific self-help courses. Our school systems have also been saturated with these concepts.

With this in mind, we as Christians should soberly examine the attitudes of the leaders of the New Age Movement towards Christianity. They are readily available in their own writings. Alice Bailey, one of the leading New Age writers was very vocal in her attack upon Christianity - blaming all the world's ills on Christian beliefs.

"Calvin and all who followed his lead made the same mistake, and instead of holding before the people ... the realization that those who recognized their essential divinity did so symbolically on behalf of all developing, incarnating sons of God, they regarded themselves as the Chosen People and all who did not think as they did are regarded as lost When the Jew and the narrow-minded religious devotees recognize their identity with all other people and express this identity through right relationship, we shall see a very different world. The world problem is essentially a religious problem and behind all strife in every department of world thought today is to be found the religious element." (The Destiny of The Nations, by Alice A. Bailey, Lucis Publishing Company, New York, 1949, pp. 34-35.)

New Agers refer to their belief system as "The Plan" and woe to anyone who does not agree with them! Alice Bailey makes this clear in the same publication, proclaiming that any Christian who teaches the judgment of God and the divinity of Jesus Christ, not of man, is an enemy of humanity and will be destroyed. (Ibid., p. 17)

This teaching is also being pushed through a new "fad" which has rapidly spread around the world called channelling.

A channeler is nothing more than an old fashioned spiritualist medium. Channelers are people who usually put themselves into a trance, or state of unconsciousness, allowing a demon to speak directly through them.

The amount of precise coordination within Satan's kingdom is amazing. Demons, speaking through the channelers, (sometimes called trance-channelers) around the world in many different languages and countries, are all saying the same thing.

Their message is summed up best by a particular demon called Asher, who is the guiding spirit for John Randolph Price (one of the New Age leaders whose works I quoted earlier in this chapter).

Asher makes some rather revealing statements about Satan's plans for the earth. "Nature will soon enter her cleansing cycle. Those who reject the earth changes . . . will be removed during the next two decades. Those who expect change and face it calmly with faith will move through it virtually untouched and will be the builders of the future." (Price]

"What I am hearing is both horrible and hopeful. I know that one of the most serious problems we have today is overpopulation, but wiping more than 2 billion people of the face of the earth is a little drastic, don't you think?"



"Asher replied, 'I can only tell you what I see at the present time. I might add ... who are we to say that those people did not volunteer to be a part of the destruction and regeneration - for the purpose of soul growth?'" (The Super Beings, by John Randolph Price, QuartusBooks, 1981, pp.l8-19)

Alice Bailey's writings and many others clearly show that the Christians are the first ones to be killed in this "cleansing cycle." Sound chilling?

For those who saw "Out On A Limb" part II, you may remember David Manning telling Shirley MacLaine, "There are no victims in this world. Everything happens just as it should ... No one ever dies, that's the point." The doctrine of reincarnation teaches that no one ever dies, they just reincarnate and enter a new stage of "soul growth."

Another leading author wrote: "(When people accept the truth of reincarnation) the nagging fear of death would be eliminated and replaced with acceptance of the opportunity for transformation. Doctors who strive to prolong life ... would see themselves as sad clowns flaunting their ignorance of cosmic renewal." (Case for Reincarnation, by Joe Fisher, p. 189)

The term "cosmic renewal" means the supposed upward evolution achieved each time a person is reincarnated into another live.

In the New Age form of Hinduism people are taught that each time they reincarnate that they come back as a person and grow more spiritually until the point where they no longer need to inhabit a physical body. There is no such thing as murder under this system of thought.

How better to stop any out-cry against persecution of Christians? During the time of the writing of this book I had the interesting experience of attending a lecture by Benjamin Creme, one of the leading spokesmen for the New Age Movement.

He is the one who has, on at least three occasions, placed a full page ad in the U.S.A. Today newspaper stating that "The Christ is Now Here." The name of his "Christ" is Lord Maitreya.

The meeting was held in a large and wealthy Episcopal church in North Hollywood, California. I suppose there were 400 or more people present. This experience was a real-life demonstration of Satan's plans for our nation and for Christians which I think would be worthwhile describing in some detail.

I went with three other Christians. Before entering the church we spent time in prayer asking the Lord specifically to bind the demons so that the audience could not be hypnotized or deceived. The meeting started with an announcement that ten minutes of silence would be observed during which everyone was supposed to meditate to receive an "overshadowing" and "blessing" from Lord Maitreya through Benjamin Creme.



The results were very interesting. Benjamin sat on a straight chair in the center of the stage and quickly went into a meditative trance. His breathing slowed to such an extent that his face, neck and hands became mottled and blue from lack of oxygen.

His whole positioning and appearance took on a peculiarly reptilian nature. His eyes were very different than his own, extremely piercing and black.

I felt as if suddenly I was looking at a corpse who's only sign of life was the burning eyes of the demon inside. He gazed unblinkingly out over the audience, very slowly turning his head from side to side - that is, until he came to our side of the room.

He obviously ran into some trouble there! The Lord gave us a momentary vision in our spirits of his attempt to layer demons out over the audience to obtain control over their minds. But it didn't work for the most part, and the supposed 10 minutes dragged out to 45 minutes as the struggle for control ensued.

The audience became very restless, whispering, shuffling their feet and rustling papers. We sat there quietly rebuking and binding the demons.

However, the hypnotic demonic power in his gaze (or I should say, the demons gaze) was some of the most powerful I have ever experienced. We had to actively resist in the name of Jesus to keep our minds from blanking out and falling under the power of that demonic gaze. I can understand just how easily an unwary person could fall completely under that control, and a person who does not have the power and authority of Jesus available to them just doesn't stand a chance.

Some of the people who were practiced in meditation quickly fell into a trance and were obviously completely oblivious to their surroundings. How sad it was to see so many people freely giving up the precious God-given gift of their minds and free wills to demonic control.

After the 45 minutes, Benjamin placed his hands together in an attitude of obeisance and bowed low, giving worship and honour to the demon called Lord Maitreya. Then a church official stood up and made an announcement that anyone who tried to question, disagree with, or refute anything Benjamin had to say would be arrested and removed by the police for causing a disturbance. No freedom of speech there!

I was most interested that Benjamin felt it necessary to spend the first 30 minutes of his lecture ridiculing and attempting to prove false the widespread Christian teaching of a Rapture. Considering the amount of controversy amongst Christian circles regarding a Rapture, I was fascinated that Satan apparently considers the teaching enough of a threat to have his servant spend so much time opposing it.

Benjamin was clearly fulfilling the prophecy in II Peter.

"Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation ... The Lord is not slack concerning his promise ... the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night ... " II Peter 3:3,4,9,10



After trying to discredit any teaching on the return of Jesus Christ, Benjamin spent the next hour freely reinterpreting all of history, science and the Bible, twisting it all to fit his theory of reincarnation. Through it all he continually repeated the same theme: there are two major enemies of mankind - the United States of America and the fundamentalistic Christians! He stated that both must be brought to an end if the human race was to survive on planet Earth. The audience clapped their approval.

He stated many times that the U.S. is the "glutton of the world, using up three-fourths of the world's energy and natural resources." I was horrified to see the blind acceptance of such statements by the audience.

There we were, sitting in a supposedly Christian church, forbidden from speaking any opposing opinion under threat of police action, listening to statements from a man who wants to abolish the God-given freedoms we enjoy in this country and do away with all Christians, with the complete approval of citizens of the U.S. who are benefiting from those very freedoms!

I don't think the average Christian in this country has any idea just how far Satan has already gone towards the establishment of his One World Government! There are a seemingly endless number of organizations, groups, philosophies, self-help courses, subliminal tapes, yoga classes and on and on, which are all involved in the New Age beliefs. It is not possible to list them all, but there is no need for such a list. All you have to do is closely check out their beliefs and teachings with God's word, the Bible, and you will quickly find out that this basic error is present in all of them. Satan is so very deceptive.

David Spangler, another of the New Age leaders makes a very interesting statement ... I see the new age not just as a vision but as a very real spirit." (Emergence, the Rebirth of the Sacred, by David Spangler, Dell Publishing Company, 1984, p. 84)

David is right, the spirit of the new age is none other than Satan himself, the anti-Christ. We mut test the spirits or we will be pulled straight down into an eternity in hell. Sharing the Gospel with New Agers.

These people are an extremely difficult group to share the gospel with for several reasons. (1) They are demonically controlled. (2) They have allowed their minds to become very passive through meditative practices. (3) Their belief in reincarnation. (4) Many of them have experienced astral projection. (5) They have accepted the teaching that each person has their own "truth" and that we each create our own "reality."

Here are some suggestions as to how to approach these people with the gospel.

1. I wrote rather extensively about the problem of sharing the gospel with people who are demonically controlled in He Came To Set The Captives Free, and in Chapter 10 Prepare for War.

I will not give more details here, these same principles apply to sharing the gospel with New Agers. They are all demonically bound.



2. You must understand that these people are frequently in a state similar to being drugged. Their minds have become so passive that they have an extremely difficult time evaluating any new concept. Not only will you need much patience to help them assimilate the concepts of the gospel, but once they actually accept Jesus Christ as their Saviour, you will need to help them regain control of their minds. You must let them know that they must stop all meditation at once.

Each time they blank out their minds they have directly opened themselves up to an inflow of demons. All of these people will need deliverance after they accept Jesus Christ. A good understanding of the concepts in Chapter 15 in Prepare for War is essential for these people.

The mind is sort of like a muscle, it becomes flabby without use and the process of regaining control is painful. Meditation is an escape from pain and reality. It also gives them a demonic "high" very similar to cocaine or other such drugs. In this sense, meditation is extremely addictive, not only because of the demons involved, but also simply because of the pleasure it gives.

Just as drug addicts not only have the physical withdrawal symptoms to cope with, they also desire and crave the drugs because of the pleasure they give. Once the demons are cast out, then the person will have a tremendous struggle with his natural, sinful, fleshly desires for the pleasure and highs obtained through either drugs or meditation.

3. In the Western Hemisphere, a subtle "acceptable" form of Hinduism and reincarnation is taught. Reincarnation is considered a curse in India and other Eastern nations because the neverending cycle or "wheel" of endless reincarnations is a terrible burden.

Also, they believe that they can be reincarnated into anything - a bird, animal, tree, etc. Nearly endless ceremonies have been invented to help the people reach a "unity" with Brahman.

Here in the West, it is taught that people always reincarnate as people, and that every reincarnation is in an upward direction of greater and greater spiritual evolution.

In talking with some people who have come out of the New Age Movement, the common thing that seemed to first start them thinking their teachings may be wrong was the fact that they didn't really have any proof for their beliefs.

Christianity, on the other hand, has the testimony of a man, Jesus Christ, who was dead for three days, resurrected, and returned to testify about life after death. Also, let us look at the words of an ex-guru.

"What good would a thousand physical births do? Reincarnation could give me a new body, but that wasn't what I needed ... It was folly to think that I would improve by coming back into this world in different bodies again and again! ... There was something wrong with me that changing the body I lived in would never solve In the past I had sought mystical experiences as an escape from the daily life which Hindu philosophy called maya - an illusion.



Now I wanted the power to face life, to live the life God had planned for me. I wanted to experience a deep change in what I was, not merely the superficial peace I felt during meditation but which left me the moment I lost my temper. I needed to be born again - spiritually, not physically." (Escape into the Light, by Rabindranath R. Maharaj, Harvest House Publishers, 1977, pp. 119-120)

The Bible leaves no room for reincarnation. "And it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment." Hebrews 9:27 4.

The experience of astral projection is a very powerful one.

4. The terrible poverty and famine in India gives us a good indication of what the Hindu teachings will do for a population when put into practice on a wide scale. Ultimately, people do have to exist in this physical world.

The Bible deals with hard facts. It is solid teaching and records which have ample historical proof. The challenge to these people is, "How do you know you aren't being deceived, and how do you know the spirits you are in contact with are not deceiving you?" Ultimately, they have no standard against which they can test anything. I recommend the books Escape into the Light, by Rabindranath R. Maharaj and The Beautiful Side of Evil, by Johanna Michelson for further reading on this subject.

Sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ with the New Agers and indeed, anyone involved in Eastern religions is very difficult. But remember, you are dealing directly with demonic powers in these people. Only the power of Jesus Christ can overcome the many obstacles to bringing these people to salvation.

This ends the basic understanding of Hinduism and the New Age and their demonic concepts.

So we now return to our listing of doctrines of devils – Yoga, Transcendental Mediation and Reincarnation.

5. Yoga

Yoga is a crucial part of Hindusim.

It's a Sanskrit word that means to 'yoke' oneself with the divine deities of Hinduism, by means of exercise, correct and positioned breathing postures, diet, meditation and deeper meditation.

'Every' single position in yoga, sitting, standing or lying down is a demonically designated position-of-prayer to the very same demonic 'gods' by which millions of devoted Hindus followers are demonised daily.



It is also remains one of the most silent by deadly lurking dangers in the realm of demonic manipulation in the western world who have extensively borrowed the science of the east.

6. Transcendental Meditation (TM)

Transcendental Meditation is a form of meditation in Hinduism that was created in 1958 by the then well known Maharishi Mahesh Yogi.

The initiation and practice changes according to the teacher and the country, but the basic stages still have each student producing a cotton handkerchief, a certain amount of cash, a bowl of freshly picked fruit and flowers. This is to be placed at the feet of a photograph of a dead guru. Then the yogi (teacher) will instruct the new recruit privately of the very secret word of phrase, known to Hindus as mantra.

In the 2nd level of consciousness attained in TM, you are able to astral project, i.e. your spirit leaves your body and travels in the demonic realm of the spirit.

Key Point to Note

Ex Guru Roby, who converted to Christianity in the late seventies, shared that the very secret mantras he would issue to hundreds of westerners in the late sixties and seventies were in fact personal names of evil spirits and demonic entities that ruled and resided over the Hindu ceremonies and temples daily.

A second key point to note is that Ex Guru Roby made another startling discovery while counselling countless hippies and drug addicts who turned to Jesus.

The music, colours and hallucinations filled with terrifying faces seen by most of the drug addicts (especially those taking hallucinogenics) were <u>exact</u> same faces, colours and sounds he had experienced for so many years as a Hindu priest in the temples of India.

7. Reincarnation

Hindusim espouses that each person is reborn again and again and again through reincarnation.

Reincarnation is known as the great escape in Hinduism for personal sin, as Hinduism offers no salvation for its followers.

Nor can Hinduism produce any form of personal saviour because all of their millions of gods are in the form of animal, insect, plant, wood, stones, statutes or mud.

Likewise, there is no forgiveness, as Hindus are brainwashed and indoctrinated by the priests to believe that a crime such as child abuse, murder, theft or adultery is simply paid for in your next life by the person coming back in a lower caste (social status or class).

Thus atrocities are carried out by Hindus in 'this' life with them believing that any price they pay will be in their next life, although they would have no recollection of the sins they committed in a previous life nor against whom!



Belief in and/or dabbling with this has grave consequences for everyone.

8. Karate (ZEN)

High priests all practice Karate Zen as the bows, gestures, positions, kicks, blows and powerful cries from the pit of the stomach are the same used in Satanism worldwide.

Phil Botha was forced to study Karate Zen under a few masters and his spirit-guide boasted of this particular doctrine he inspired in the Lama Tibetan monks to create and form.

There were only 25 original styles created and each named after a deceased monk, hence demonic spirits responsible for the creation of this sport still teach all priests in satanism that Karate means 'I surrender' and Zen to 'Zen Buddha'.

In 2016 onwards Chinese/oriental students continue to debate with those in India practising 'their' art and arguing where they believe Karate originated from.

Yet history books show that Han Lo-Ming (born in India) used an unusual style of combat.

Regardless of which country you live in or what martial art you participate in , if you they are derived from the same occultic origins.

Participating in Karate is an occultic sin with dire consequences for the those participating and more significantly for those who are Christians.

Key Point to Note

Chinese Kung-Fu also has demonic origins and as such is also detrimental to those participating in it and once again more significantly so for those who are Christians.
